

# Early Conditional Admission Process for Current Alberta, NWT, and Nunavut High School Students

## Early Conditional Applicants should submit:

### Step 1: Apply

- An Application for Undergraduate Admission which can be submitted online or by filling out the form (for Education and Nursing programs, applicants can go to <https://urconnected.uregina.ca/> for more information)
- The application fee (currently \$100.00-subject to change)
- An official high school transcript showing final grades to date OR a school certified transcript
- A schedule or list of all grade 12 courses planned (may be listed directly on the Application)

### Application Deadlines \*

<b>Fall Semester</b> (Sept-Dec) Priority Deadline**: March 15 Application Deadline: June 1	<b>Winter Semester</b> (Jan-Apr) Priority Deadline**: November 1 Application Deadline: December 1	<b>Faculty of Education</b> (Fall Semester Only): Application Deadline: March 1 <b>Faculty of Nursing</b> (Fall Semester Only): Application Deadline: February 15 International Applicants applying to the Faculty of Nursing must apply by December 31
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\*Journalism (not Pre-Journalism), Bachelor of Social Work (not Pre-Social Work), Indigenous Education, and Centre for Continuing Education programs have other deadlines.

\*\* Priority Deadline: The recommended deadline to ensure best course selection and opportunities for enrolment and other university services such as scholarships, residence, and parking.

### EC Average is calculated using the best 5 courses listed below (minimum 65% average required; see reverse for Faculty-specific averages):

The higher of the Final Mark or the School Mark will be used in the calculation (final mark must be over 50%).

#### Faculties of Business, Engineering & Applied Science, Kinesiology & Health Studies, Nursing, and Science:

1. One English Language Arts or Français Language Arts course (20-1- or 30-1-level)
2. One Math course from Category A (20- or 30-level)
3. One Category A course (20- or 30-level)
4. One Category B course (20- or 30-level)
5. One additional course from Category A or B (20- or 30-level)

#### Faculties of Arts; Education; Media, Art, and Performance; Social Work; and the Centre for Continuing Education:

1. One English Language Arts or Français Language Arts course (20-1- or 30-1-level)
2. One Category A course (20- or 30-level)
3. One Category B course (20- or 30-level)
4. One additional course from Category A or B (20- or 30-level)
5. One additional course from Category A or B (20- or 30-level)

The following notes apply to both columns above:

- Maximum of 2 math courses to be used
- Maximum of one course to be used marked with a\*
- Two 3-credit hour courses must be taken to equal one 5-credit course
- Requirements 3, 4, 5 must be met by different subjects
- Math courses in Category A marked \*\* cannot be used for admission to Arts, Business, Engineering, Kinesiology, Nursing, or Science
- Courses in Category B marked \* cannot be used for admission to Nursing

### Step 2: Submit Final Transcripts

- Final admission will be calculated using Faculty specific admission subjects (see other side).
- **Final, official high school transcripts must be submitted to the Admissions Office by August 1.**
- If the student's final admission average does not meet University admission requirements, the applicant's conditional admission will be revoked and he/she will be withdrawn from courses.

# ALBERTA/NWT/NUNAVUT FINAL ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

A minimum of 5 approved grade 12 courses required, and a minimum average of **65%** required on listed subjects (unless otherwise noted).

**The higher of the Final Mark or the School Mark will be used (final mark must be over 50%).**
