Student Awards & Financial Aid

We want to help students pay for school! Encourage them to apply for entrance awards and remind them that they will automatically be considered for the following awards:

AUTOMATIC ENTRANCE AWARDS

Centennial Merit Scholarship

\$2,000 Value

- EC or final admission average of 90 - 94.99%
- Students applying directly from a Canadian high school or a Canadian Citizen applying directly from a foreign high school.

Centennial Merit Plus Scholarship

\$3,000 Value

- EC or final admission average of 95% or higher
- Students applying directly from a Canadian high school or a Canadian Citizen applying directly from a foreign high school.

UR Circle of Scholars Entrance Scholarship

\$20,000 Value (\$5,000 x 4 years)

- 10 awards given to the top students in each of the identified regions within Canada
- \$5,000 in first year, renewable for additional three years

Business Excellence Scholarship

\$1,000 Value

- EC or final admission average of 85+
- Students entering the Bachelor of Business Administration degree program in the Paul J. Hill School of Business.

New Certificate in Nonprofit Sector Leadership and Innovation

This dynamic, multidisciplinary certificate is designed for students who want to acquire the expertise to pursue paid employment and/or voluntary work in the nonprofit sector.

Environmental Health and Science

The Environmental Health and Science program is now housed under the Faculty of Science. The ENHS program is accredited through the Canadian Institute of Public Health Inspectors, which provides graduates with the eligibility to sit for the national exam to obtain a Certificate in Public Health Inspection.
