**AUTOMATIC SCHOLARSHIPS**

**Centennial Merit Scholarship - \$2000** (admission average 90-94.99%)

**Centennial Merit Plus Scholarship - \$3000** (admission average 95%+)

**Business Excellence Scholarship - \$1000** (for Faculty of Business with admission average 85%+)

These scholarships are automatically offered at the point of admission to qualifying students applying directly from a Canadian high school for the Fall semester. The calculation for the scholarships is based on your Early Conditional Admission Average, and will not be taken away if your final average is lower.

**UR Circle of Scholars Scholarship - \$20,000**

This amazing scholarship program was created to recognize the best and brightest first year students from 10 different regions in Saskatchewan and Canada entering the University of Regina each Fall. The scholarship is paid over 4 years (\$5,000 each year) to the student from each region with the highest Early Conditional Admission Average. New students coming directly from high school who apply for admission to the Fall semester by March 15 are automatically eligible.

**APPLICATION-BASED SCHOLARSHIPS**

**SAMS (Student Awards Management System)**

The benefits of applying for scholarship using SAMS, the U of R online scholarship application system are:

- Keep track of your U of R scholarship applications in one place
- View the status of your applications throughout the selection process
- One common personal statement for all U of R scholarships you apply for
- Great searching tools to make sure you don't miss out on the funding you qualify for

The University of Regina has four award competitions throughout the year where students must complete an award application to be considered. Current high school students will apply for scholarships on the Entrance Awards Competition, which will open January 15, 2016 and close on March 15, 2016.

Competition Name	When is the application available?	Who can apply?
Entrance Competition	January to March 15	Students entering the U of R for the first time in the upcoming Fall semester
Fall Competition	September to October	Current and new U of R students and students in their first semester at the U of R
Winter Competition	January to February	Current or continuing U of R students
Spring Competition	May to June	Current or continuing U of R students

## STUDENT LOANS

In Saskatchewan, students who apply for Student Loans are automatically considered for three forms of financial assistance. In addition to student loans, you will also be automatically considered for grants and bursaries from both the Government of Canada and the Government of Saskatchewan. That is money for school that students won't need to ever pay back! Last year, 56% of the Saskatchewan assistance provided was non-repayable.
