

Early Conditional Admission Process for Current Saskatchewan High School Students



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Early Conditional Applicants must submit:

- An Application for Undergraduate Admission which can be submitted online or by filling out the form (Education and Nursing program applicants can go to urconnected.uregina.ca for more information)
- The application fee (currently \$100.00 - subject to change)
- An official high school transcript showing final grades to date **OR** a school certified transcript
- A schedule or list of all grade 12 courses planned (may be listed directly on the Application)
